

Welcome to the Screened Chemistry for Commodity Chemicals Program

Screened Chemistry Brands are requiring suppliers (i.e., mills, laundries, and other facilities) to screen commodity chemicals used in processes for the presence of ZDHC MRSL analytes.

Over the coming months, these brands will be requiring all suppliers to make use of a fast and cost-effective Screened Chemistry for Commodity Chemicals ("SC for CC") certification process that these brands have developed for this step in the program.

Scivera (USA) is collaborating with NimkarTek Technical Services Pvt Ltd. (India) to provide cost-effective and efficient screening, scoring, certification, and data management processes for Screened Chemistry Brand facilities.

The Scivera-NimkarTek process for screening and certifying textile commodity chemicals is authorized by Screened Chemistry Brands.

If you are a supplier to Screened Chemistry Brands, please follow the steps detailed below for the screening of your commodity chemicals.

SC for CC PROCESS STEPS

1. Download the [Scivera Screened Chemistry for Commodity Chemicals \("SC for CC"\) Application](#), or
2. Use the SC for CC online platform (coming soon) to create an account for your company.
3. Enter information into the downloaded form or online form (coming soon) for each commodity chemical from all suppliers.
4. Send the completed form to screenedchemistry@scivera.com or confirm the online completed application form (coming soon).
5. Scivera will send a quote and Chemical Sample Transmittal document for the requested SC for CC services.
6. Review the Scivera SC for CC Sample Transmittal document, which includes information for preparing and shipping chemical samples to the NimkarTek Laboratory.
7. Prepare a sample of each commodity chemical as per instructions provided in the [SC for CC Sampling Guidelines](#).
8. Pack and ship the commodity chemical samples to the NimkarTek Laboratory.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Some commodity chemicals used in textile processes are classified as Dangerous Goods by IATA. Commodity chemicals that are classified as Dangerous Goods by IATA are not allowed to be shipped by air courier even in sample quantities.

When completing your SC for CC Application Form, please list all commodity chemicals used in your facility in Section II of the application form. Please indicate in column "IATA DG" if the chemical is IATA Dangerous Goods or not (y/n). For any commodity chemical marked "y", Scivera will exclude this commodity chemical from the resulting SC for CC Sample Transmittal document for use during sample shipping.

IATA Dangerous Goods designation can be found on the Safety Data Sheet (SDS) for the commodity chemical in Section 14.
